Management Report for Third Fiscal Quarter 2025

Hsinchu, Taiwan, November 14th, 2025 – eMemory Technology Inc. (TPE: 3529) reported financial results for its fiscal quarter, which ended September 30th, 2025.

Executive Summary

- Q3 2025 revenue was NT\$ 952.42 million, up 1.7% sequentially and up 5.9% year-over-year. Operating Margin was 57.6%, down 0.7 ppt QoQ but up 1.5 ppts YoY. Net income was NT\$ 487.14 million, an increase of 21.8% sequentially and an increase of 17.7% year-over-year.
- Licensing growth will be driven by:
 - √ 10 years contract including 18 3nm tape outs for US defense applications and 3nm CPU for AI server will drive strong PUF security license growth.
 - ✓ Strong licenses for embedded ReRAM and NeoFlash technologies that replace external memories.
- Royalty growth is expected to accelerate due to customers' tape outs moving into mass production for:
 - ✓ RF chips for a leading U.S. smartphone customer's in-house modem module.
 - ✓ DDR5-related applications for a major Korean memory manufacturer.
 - ✓ Al servers featuring secure BMCs, SSD controllers, and networking chips.
 - ✓ Automotive applications in ADAS, networking.
 - ✓ Secure embedded controllers for PC/ NB.
 - ✓ ASIC applications from various customers.

New IP Technology and Business Development

- ✓ Collaborating with Arm to develop PUF-based Security Root of Trust to enhance the security capabilities of Arm's Runtime Security Engine.
- ✓ Working with automotive system suppliers and hospitals to provide a PUF-based HSM server platform for OTA software protection and DID-based personal privacy protection.

Financial Review

Gross margin

The gross margin remained at 100%.

Operating expenses

The total operating expenses in Q3 2025 were NT\$ 404.07 million and represented 42.4% of the total revenue. The operating expenses were up 3.4% QoQ and up 2.4% YoY.

Non-operating items and income tax expense

- Non-operating gain for the quarter was NT\$ 33.47 million, mainly due to a foreign exchange gain of NT\$ 21.48 million and interest income of NT\$ 11.02 million.
- Q1-Q3 2025 effective tax rate was 16.4%.

Net Income and EPS

- Net income attributable to shareholders of the company for the quarter was NT\$ 487.14 million, an increase of 21.8% sequentially and an increase of 17.7% year-over-year.
- Earnings per share was NT\$ 6.52 in Q3 2025. ROE was 57%.

Current assets and current liabilities

- As of September 30th, 2025, cash decreased by NT\$ 1,539.04 million from June 30th, 2025, to NT\$ 2,746.42 million.
- Total current assets including cash totaled NT\$ 3,084.40 million, with a decrease of NT\$ 1,482.11 million from June 30th, 2025.

- Total current liabilities decreased by NT\$ 1,923.76 million from June 30th, 2025, to NT\$ 765.03 million.
- The net working capital was NT\$ 2,319.37 million and the current ratio was 4x.

Cash flows

- As of September 30th, 2025, net cash generated from operating activities totaled NT\$ 1,388.99 million, including NT\$ 1,604.03 million from income before income tax, NT\$ 131.08 million from depreciation and amortization, and NT\$ 346.12 million used in other operating activities.
- Net cash used in investing activities was NT\$ 304.36 million in Q1-Q3 2025, primarily related to the increase in capital expenditure.
- Net cash used in financing activities was NT\$ 1,616.91 million in Q1-Q3 2025, mainly attributable to the dividend payout.
 - As a result, total cash decreased from NT\$ 3,307.75 million to NT\$ 2,746.42 million from December 31st, 2024, to September 30th, 2025.

Employee

As of September 30th, 2025, eMemory has 304 full-time employees, including 220 R&D engineers. Our subsidiaries, PUFsecurity has 40 full-time employees, including 28 R&D engineers, and eMemory Japan has 2 full-time employees.
